

English IV Poverty and Hunger Video Guidelines

Please read the following instructions carefully concerning the guidelines and parameters for your final iMovie for the Poverty and Hunger assignment.

Content (100 points):

Each video should contain references (photographs, brief video clips, interviews) of the agencies or people who visited our classroom:

- Hamilton County Food Pantry
- The Memorial Hospital Thrift Shop
- Elementary BackPack Program
- County Commissioner or City Council Member
- Ministerial Association
- Habitat for Humanity
- Hamilton Community Foundation

Also: *Fact Sheets* (or statistical information from them), *Flyer* (or information promoting the above agencies), interviews with other students, faculty or administrators or other community members.

Special Effects (20 points):

Each video should contain 3-4 special effects (transitions, color, etc.) and a **Title** and **End Credits**.

Team Members (20 points):

Each person on your team should **appear or be heard** in the video in some capacity in an **appropriate manner**. This is a formal and professional presentation and students should act accordingly.

Music (10 points):

Music should be “school appropriate” which means the music should not contain any explicit language or vulgar references. You can utilize the music in iMovie or find appropriate music at a public domain music site.
